with support for young people aged 15-25

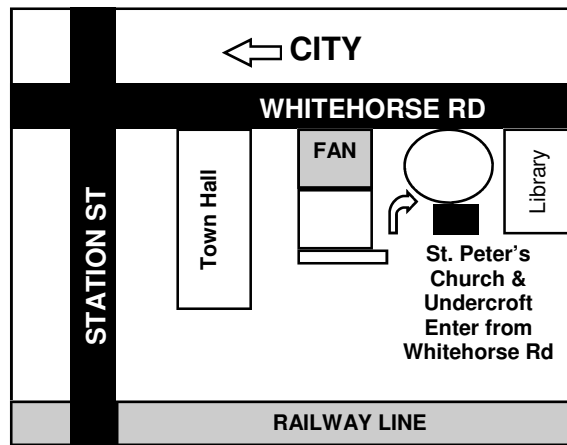
Creative *Life Skills Programs* offer a range of free workshops

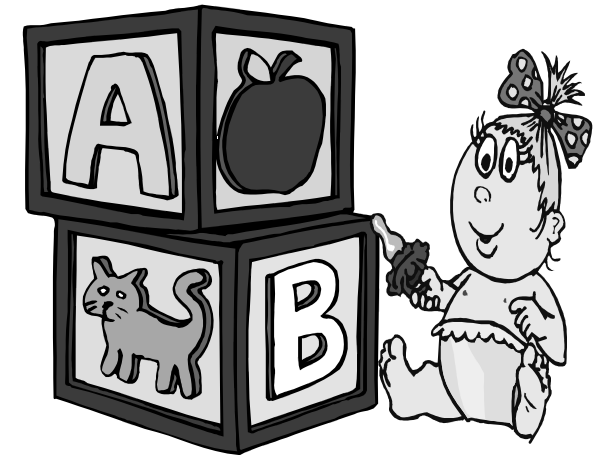

- Child friendly activities

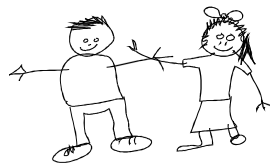
