

LGBTIQ Youth Property Lead Tenant – Position Available

Position Vacant Lead Tenant - Family Access Network (FAN) Located in Chadstone

Family Access Network (FAN) work with young people aged 15-25 who are homeless or those at risk of homelessness. FAN offer a range of services one of which is our *ALSORTS Program*, a transitional housing response for Lesbian, Gay, Bi-sexual, Transgender, Intersex and Questioning young people. The pilot project commenced in 2006 and continues to this day. Family Access Network is currently seeking to engage a Lead Tenant aged 21 or over to assist us to support three young people in a shared living house within our *Alsorts* Model. This is a voluntary live-in position that involves a 12 month commitment in exchange for rent free accommodation. You will have your own bedroom and bathroom.

The Lead Tenant is required, in liaison with the agency, to ensure that house rules are maintained. The Lead Tenant is not a professional support role but rather a positive role model living in a shared property. The Lead Tenant would pay for their own food and cleaning products, utility bills are only \$30.00 per week.

Ideally suited to someone who is interested in, or actively studying, in the Human Services Field. This position offers ongoing training and support. The purpose of the position is to act as a role model for young people to help them to live and share in independent accommodation. This position would suit someone who is prepared to spend most nights at home. We require good living skills, an understanding of youth issues, and the ability to communicate effectively with young people.

You will be required to pass a satisfactory Working With Children Check, Police Check and to sign a tenancy agreement.
