Homeless Support Services

The Homeless Support Services (HSS) program provides:

- Access to medium term transitional accommodation with support for young people aged 15-25 years who are experiencing/are at risk of homelessness. The accommodation available includes: shared independent, shared lead tenant; shared and sole properties for young pregnant and parenting women, families and couples.
- Support to maintain housing and access to private rental, public and other housing options.
- Ongoing assistance and/or referral for support with issues such as: legal, abuse of alcohol and other drugs, counselling, mental health, domestic violence, budgeting/debt, employment/education, child-related needs, etc.
- Family Access Network also provides a transitional accommodation response for Same Sex Attracted, Transgender and Intersex (SSATI) young people. This response offers both a shared lead tenant property and a shared independent property solely for young people who identify as part of the SSATI community.
- All referrals for supported transitional accommodation are to be made via the Opening Doors Resource Register - except for those wanting to access SSATI supported accommodation. Referrals for this can be made by the young person themselves or via a support worker by contacting a member of the HSS team directly.
