Family Access Network requires volunteer mentors to join our team.

Mentors work one-on-one with a young person aged 15-25 years in our homeless accommodation program. Mentors provide friendship and positive role modelling, while assisting young people with the development of independent living skills.

Mentoring is flexible with days/time of contact with young people and activities undertaken negotiated with the young person and mentor.

Mentors are required to commit to 12 months with training and fortnightly support meetings provided.

People with an understanding and interest in youth issues, in particular youth homelessness encouraged to apply.
